I thought you might like to sing along with the Wonderful Waple Brother's entrance music next time they visit your local arena, so here are the lyrics.

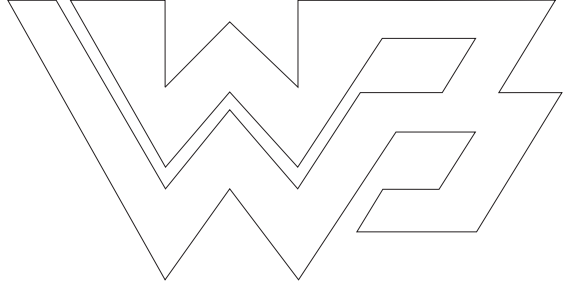
*We are the Waple Brothers

We can talk our way out of it*

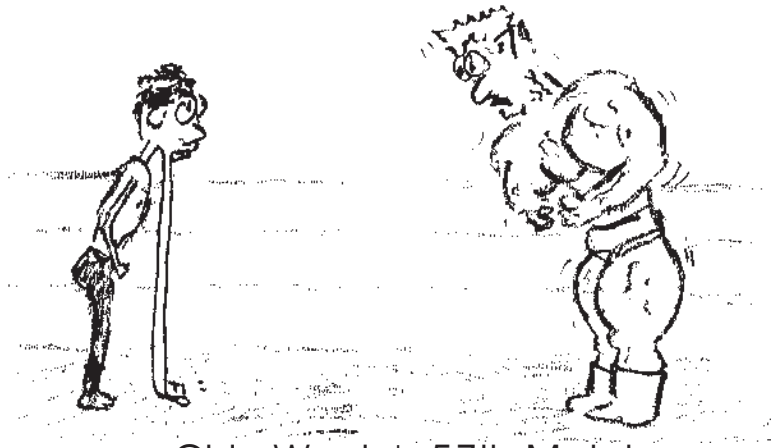
*We are the Waple Brothers
